

Jalkunen graphite project

The Jalkunen graphite project is located approximately 50km southeast of Talga's Vittangi project and has a total JORC 2012 resource of 31.5 million tonnes ("Mt") at 14.9% graphite ("Cg").

Jalkunen graphite project – Total JORC (2012) Mineral Resource Estimate

The Jalkunen graphite Mineral Resource Estimate was disclosed on 27 August 2015 in accordance with the 2012 JORC Code (ASX:TLG 27 August 2015).

Exploration History

Graphite at Jalkunen was noted in outcrops by the Geological Survey of Sweden and in historical diamond drillholes targeting electromagnetic conductors for base metals. In March 2015 Talga completed a diamond drilling program at the Jalkunen prospect covering some 800 metres of strike and intersected a high grade graphite deposit averaging 50-60 metres true thickness dipping favourably at ~8 degrees (a horizontal width of ~250-300m).

A maiden 2012 JORC compliant Inferred resource was estimated of 31.5 Mt @ 14.9% Cg using a 10% graphite cut off grade (ASX:TLG 27 August 2015).

The high grade and exceptionally shallow dip of the graphite orebody offer significant advantages in the event of development. Talga continues exploration of Jalkunen in step with timing and development of its Vittangi project 50km to the northwest.
